

Selecting Apple Trees 2026

Selecting Your Apple Trees: We have chosen varieties that will not only survive but also flourish in Montana. At Swan River Gardens, you won't find trees for many supermarket apple varieties like Granny Smith, Gala, or Fuji as they are not hardy enough for our climate. The trees or more often, the flower buds, simply cannot withstand the conditions here.

Apples require cross-pollination: -- bees moving pollen from a pollen-donating tree to the receiving tree. Pollen-donating trees must be a compatible cultivar or simply put another variety apple tree that has an overlapping flowering period. For example, a Macintosh cannot pollinate another Macintosh. Another variety such as Red Wealthy or Liberty is needed. You will see that Swan River Gardens apple trees have color coded strip tags that help you pair varieties correctly. The letters **(E) early**, **(M) mid** or **(L) late** season are used to describe the bloom times for apples so look for these terms if you are selecting varieties elsewhere. An **(E) early**-season will have overlapping flowering with another **(E) early**-season as well as a **(M) mid**-season. A **(M) mid**-season tree will have overlapping flowering with an **(E) early**, **(M) mid** and **(L) late**-season. **(L) late**-season trees bloom period will overlap with a **(M) mid**-season or **(L) late**-season tree.

Trees will not care if you plant one this year and its mate the next. Just be sure to keep track of which type you have planted.
